Anticipate Your Costs

The traditional academic year includes fall, winter and spring quarters. Full-time enrollment is 15 hours per quarter.

Secure Your Aid

SCAD Financial Aid Application—All new students must complete the SCAD Financial Aid application in order for your financial aid to be credited to your student account. The SCAD Financial Aid application is located at www.scad.edu/financialaid under the forms tab. Please complete this form and return to the financial aid office.

Loan Information—If you have been awarded a loan as part of your financial aid package, additional action on your part is required.

- Disbursement of all Federal Direct Loans requires a completed Master Promissory Note (MPN). Please visit www.dlenote.ed.gov to complete the MPN for Stafford, Graduate PLUS loan, or PLUS loan.
- First time student borrowers must fulfill the federal mandated entrance loan counseling at www.dl.ed.gov.
- Federal PLUS (Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students) loans may be available, based on credit approval, as a resource to pay for educational expenses. *Parents must apply and be approved for this loan.* Parents can print the application from the forms page at www.scad.edu/financialaid.
- Private, or alternative, loans are available to assist with covering the cost of educational expenses, to apply visit www.elmselect.com.
- A loan origination fee will be deducted from loan proceeds when funds are disbursed.

Georgia Aid—If you are applying for Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant (GTEG) and/or HOPE Scholarship, please complete all required applications and submit all supporting documents. Instructions and applications to apply online are available at www.gacollege411.org.

Merit Scholarships—Merit scholarships may be renewed with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

Maintain Your Eligibility

Financial aid is renewable upon timely annual re-application. Be sure to do the following each year:

- Submit your FAFSA after January 1st each year
- Respond promptly to all inquiries from the Financial Aid Office
- Make satisfactory progress toward your degree
