

# what to bring

Contact your roommate(s) prior to arrival to coordinate items.

## Items to bring

- Alarm clock/clock radio
- Bed linens, pillows, blanket(s) (all beds are twin extra long—36" x 80")
- Cleaning supplies
- Clip light for drafting table (may be purchased at Ex Libris)
- Clothes hangers (hanging space is limited)
- Kitchen utensils and supplies (for apartment-style housing only)
- Laundry products
- Paper products—paper towels, bathroom and facial tissues
- Shower curtain, towels and toiletries
- Small vacuum cleaner
- Small lamp(s)
- Throw rugs (Barnard Village, Boundary Village, Pulaski House and Spring House have carpeting)
- Touch-tone telephone with answering machine
- Waste basket with plastic bags

## Other suggestions

- Bike and bike lock
- Coffee maker (with automatic shut-off)
- Dolly for move-in
- Fan
- First aid kit
- Flashlight
- Iron (with automatic shut-off)/ironing board
- Memo board
- Pail/mop/broom
- Plunger
- Sewing kit
- Small refrigerator (1.7 amps or less, 4.4-cubic-foot limit; full-sized refrigerators are provided for residents in apartment-style housing)
- Stationery/stamps
- U.L. approved power-strip extension cord (no longer than six feet) with surge protection (Fire Shield suggested)
- Umbrella

## Items not to bring

- Extension cords or multiplug adapters
- Candles, incense
- Microwaves, toaster ovens or George Foreman grills (unless in apartment-style housing with a kitchen; microwaves permitted in Spring House)
- Pets (other than fish in a tank of 10 gallons or less)
- Space heaters or halogen lamps
- Weapons, firearms or replicas
