

"Snap Shots" Summer Sales Exhibition Call for Submissions

Deadline for submissions is Monday, April 22

The SCAD exhibitions department invites SCAD students, professors, staff and alumni to submit entries for the 2013 summer sales exhibition "Snap Shots." "Snap Shots" seeks works by SCAD artists depicting imagery from around the world and considering such themes as memories, keepsakes, mementos and souvenirs of daily life; global perspectives on representations of people and places; and reflections on the notions of travel and exploration.

Submissions are welcome from artists from a range of disciplines including, but not limited to, painting, photography, sculpture, fibers, film, drawing and printmaking.

Email completed entries to Sofya Radelet, sradelet@scad.edu, using "Artist Name: Snap Shots" in the subject line. Incomplete submissions will not be considered. Limit your attachment size to 1 MB. Include the following:

- Images of individual works, with image files titled to match the works' title.
 - Images must show completed work, and images of 2-D work must incorporate the frame if the work is framed.
- Word document containing name, mailing address, email address, phone number, current SCAD status (e.g., M.F.A. painting student), with a checklist of works submitted that includes title of work, medium, dimensions, year and artist price.
 - Please note that for professors, alumni and staff, artist price is marked up 50 percent, with 30 percent for matriculated students.
- A word document résumé or CV including artist exhibition history, separated into group and solo shows, and awards and honors.
 - Do not include contact information or graphics.

Artists will be notified of a decision in a timely fashion.
