National Standards: Visual Arts

DESCRIPTION

For this assignment, students will be asked to utilize their knowledge of art terminology, art elements and principles of design to offer a thoughtful critique of a piece of artwork. Using the four steps of art criticism, vocabulary and their own interpretation, students will complete a written art critique.

PREP	PROCEDURES	
 Prepare a PowerPoint presentation on the art elements and principles of design Prepare a PowerPoint presentation on the four steps of art criticism MATERIALS Janice Mason Art Museum: Four Steps in Art Criticism Guide (attached) Various examples of art work or access to an exhibition/gallery space OBJECTIVES To gain an understanding of the elements and principles of design. To gain an understanding of the four steps in art criticism. To effectively utilize these steps in writing a critique of a work or works of art. Art Criticism Art Criticism Art Elements Principles of Design 	 Begin with a presentation on the art elements and principles of design. Review how these elements and principles are utilized in successful pieces. Discuss art criticism and the importance of evaluation in work in order to grow as an artist. Walk students through the four steps of writing a critique. Utilize an example piece or film to go through the steps as a group. Once students understand the four steps to art criticism, allow them to work in small groups practicing these steps and critiquing stock images. Assign a final critique of an exhibition or film utilizing the four steps of art criticism.
