OVERVIEW

Travel and cultural enrichment are all elements of SCAD Study Abroad and International Student Services Office's (ISSO) debut program: *Tour de Provence*. Open to all international students at SCAD, this unique program is a week-long sampler hosted at SCAD's bucolic campus in the south of France, SCAD Lacoste, and is packed with tours and excursions to local points of interest. Students will have the opportunity to hike through the cedar forest, discover the ochre mines in Rousillon, visit real French outdoor markets and sample local French treats like candied fruits and lavender infused honey. Unlock the treasures of Provence!

APPLICATION CRITERIA

Considerations for *Tour de Provence* are limited to students with a clean or resolved student conduct record. Additionally, a 2.5 GPA or higher is required by the SCAD Student Handbook for travel with the university. Students must complete the application in its entirety for acceptance, and meet all deadlines as indicated in the timeline below. Please note that visas for tourist travel to France will be necessary for particular nationalities.

COST

Program Fee (without airfare)*	\$1,660
*Includes: ground transportation in France, housing, most meals, daily excursions and site visits.	
Program Fee (with airfare)**	\$2,350
**Includes: flight to and from Europe from Savannah or Atlanta, ground transportation in France, housing, most meals, daily excursions and site visits.	

Travel requests for booking your flight through SCAD must be submitted on or before Wednesday, October 9. Students choosing to arrange their own flights should plan to book travel after official acceptance into the program.
