Matting Gold Key Artwork

2-D work should be matted with 2" white borders. Enclose 2-D artwork between rigid boards, cardboard or matte board to prevent the work from damage during transit. Protect charcoals, pastels and other delicate, dusty surfaces with the appropriate fixative and/or use acetate/glassine or wax paper to prevent work from smearing and smudging in transit.

For 3-D pieces, any installation instructions should be provided as well as storage requirements. Enclose 3-D artwork in a box with bubble wrap to prevent damage during transit. Packing peanuts must be bagged. DO NOT use loose packing peanuts.

Instructions for Gold Key Writing

All writing work should be formatted on a CD as a Word document and include the student's full name, title of piece, school, and grade in the filename and on the front of the CD.
