## **DESCRIPTION**

For this assignment, students will use the elements of design and various photographic techniques to visually communicate a word.

PREP	PROCEDURES
Prepare a PowerPoint presentation on the relationship between subject matter, form and content.  MATERIALS	Session 1  1. Begin with a presentation on subject matter, form and content. Show examples of various photographers and discuss how they use the medium to communicate a message.
<ul><li>Camera</li><li>List of five words</li></ul>	<ol> <li>Assign each student a word. Students must keep their assigned word a secret.</li> <li>Give students time to create a photograph based on their word.</li> </ol>
STUDENT OBJECTIVES      Gain an understanding of how to control the elements of design and photographic techniques to communicate a message.	<ol> <li>Session 2</li> <li>Divide a board or table into five sections, one for each word.</li> <li>Ask students to decide, as a group, where they feel each student's photograph belongs and place it in the appropriate section.</li> <li>Reveal the word each photograph was intended to represent, and discuss the results.</li> </ol>
